

Frances Carpenter Endowment Fund for the Redford Township District Library

This endowment fund was established in March 2006 in honor of Frances Carpenter, a library employee on her 90th birthday. It was established with funds donated in her honor in addition to funds donated by the Friends of the Redford Library and has ongoing donations from many people. It was thought a fitting way to honor Frances in a way that will be giving to the library she loves for many years to come.

The fund is held at the Community Foundation of Southeast Michigan, www.cfsem.org/giving. Each year as the fund grows, the library is given the opportunity to expend a percentage of the fund to benefit the library.

Making a gift to the library this way may qualify for the best federal charitable income tax deductions. Michigan taxpayers can receive a State of Michigan Community Foundation tax credit for gifts to an endowment fund at the Community Foundation. This tax credit may be up to 50% of the amount contributed. Please check with your tax advisor on tax matters.
